



HUSKY B MEMBER NOTICE OF CT BHP

We are writing to tell you about changes in the way that behavioral health services are covered under HUSKY. Behavioral health services are services for mental health or substance abuse problems. Starting January 1, 2006, the Connecticut Behavioral Health Partnership (CT BHP) will cover your behavioral health care. **There is no change in what services are covered.** The change is only in how the services are managed. Your HUSKY health plan will no longer cover these behavioral health services.

Under the CT BHP you:

- Need to use your ConnectCard (*the gray card*) to get services
- Do not need a referral to get behavioral health services
- Can call a provider directly to get care

If you do not have your ConnectCard, you may give a provider your client ID number.

There will be no change in the way medical services are covered. Your HUSKY health plan will continue to cover:

- Medical and dental services
- Medicines for medical and behavioral health care
- Transportation for medical and behavioral health appointments (HUSKY A only)

If you have questions about your medical services, please call your HUSKY health plan.

Please note: You must get care from a provider who has joined the CT BHP. To make sure your provider has joined:

- Take this notice to your provider and ask if they are in the CT BHP
