**SUBJECT:**   **Connecticut Behavioral Health Partnership Transition Plan for  
Registration of Covered Services**

This bulletin serves to remind providers of services covered under the Connecticut Behavioral Health Partnership (CT BHP) that **the initiation of the registration process for service has been deferred until further notice.** For services scheduled to require registration, providers may continue to bill EDS without registration during this transitional courtesy period.

Providers will be given advance notification via provider bulletin of the schedule for implementing the registration requirement and the process of registering clients for services.
