SUBJECT: Updated DCF Residential Program Specifications

Dear Provider,

This provider alert is a follow up to CT BHP Provider Alert 2010-05 (distributed in February of 2010) notifying CT Behavioral Health Partnership providers that the Department of Children and Families (DCF) is seeking providers who are able to provide congregate care treatment on a fee-for-service basis for the following service types:

- Residential setting for adolescent males with problem sexual behaviors
- Residential setting for adolescent males with highly aggressive behaviors and concurrent psychiatric disorders

Both programs sought are envisioned as a fee-for-service, 6-25 bed congregate care setting for males.
